I, \_\_\_\_\_, as the permittee or authorized representative of the permittee, hereby acknowledge the "Conditions of Permit" listed below and agree that the permittee will abide by, and be subject to, these conditions in all respects if a permit is issued as a result of this application. In consideration for the grant of a permit for law enforcement services ("Permit") and the law enforcement services provided in connection therewith ("Services"), permittee voluntarily assumes all risks of accidents, injury and damage to his or her person and property and hereby releases and discharges Gilchrist County and its employees, agents, officers, elected and appointed officials, and volunteers (collectively, "Indemnified Parties") from every claim, liability, and demand of any kind. Further, permittee shall defend at its expense, pay on behalf of, hold harmless and indemnify the Indemnified Parties from and against any and all claims, demands, liens, liabilities, penalties, fines, fees, judgments, losses and damages (collectively, "Claims"), whether or not a lawsuit is filed, including but not limited to costs, expenses and attorneys' and experts' fees at trial and on appeal and Claims for damage to property or bodily or personal injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any persons or entities, which Claims are alleged to have arisen out of or in connection with, in whole or in part, the Permit or Services.

**Fee Schedule/Pay: \$50.00 per hour**

(Paid to the Sheriff's Office for processing and Deputy will be paid by the Sheriff's Office)

**Permit Cancellation:**

The Sheriff's Office may cancel a permit at any time with or without cause. The permittee may cancel a permit job by contacting the Sheriff's Office 24 hours in advance of the date and time of the permit service. If cancellation does not occur within the 24 hours in advance, the permittee may be subject to a three(3) hour minimum charge per assigned deputy.

**Status of Law Enforcement Officers Performing Service:**

Law enforcement officers performing permit services under the terms of a permit will be acting within the scope of their official duties; their principal responsibility will remain to the Sheriff's Office and the general public. Their permit service assignment may be terminated at any time in the interest of the Sheriff's Office and/or the general public.

**Staffing Provision:**

The Sheriff or his/her designee will review all permit assignment applications prior to approval. Staffing needs will be evaluated. If a deficiency appears, the permittee may be required to contract for more deputies than originally requested.

**This permit will expire one year from the approval date unless otherwise indicated.**
